Psyllium husk, Sat-Isabgol, Indian Plantago, Plantago Ishagula, Isabgol, Flea, Ispaghua, Spogel, Plantago Psyllium, Isaphgol, Plantago sp., Isabgula, Plataginis Ovata Testa Botanical Names of Psyllium : Plantago Ovata, Plantago Ispaghula Psyllium Other Name : Psyllii Semen, Blond Psyllium, Sand Plantain, Plantago Arenaria, Flohsamen.

Descriptions :

When psyllium seeds are processed to make psyllium husk, the extraneous material lefts is termed as psyllium kha-kha powder. It is by-product of psyllium husk, i.e psyllium industrial dust.

Application :

- Mainly use to prevent landscaping, soilerosion.
- Used as animal feed.
- Used as thickening agent during capsule formulation in some pharmaceutical industry.
- It can be used for the construction of path-way, courts, car park, school yards and all other path surfacing used in garden design and application.
